

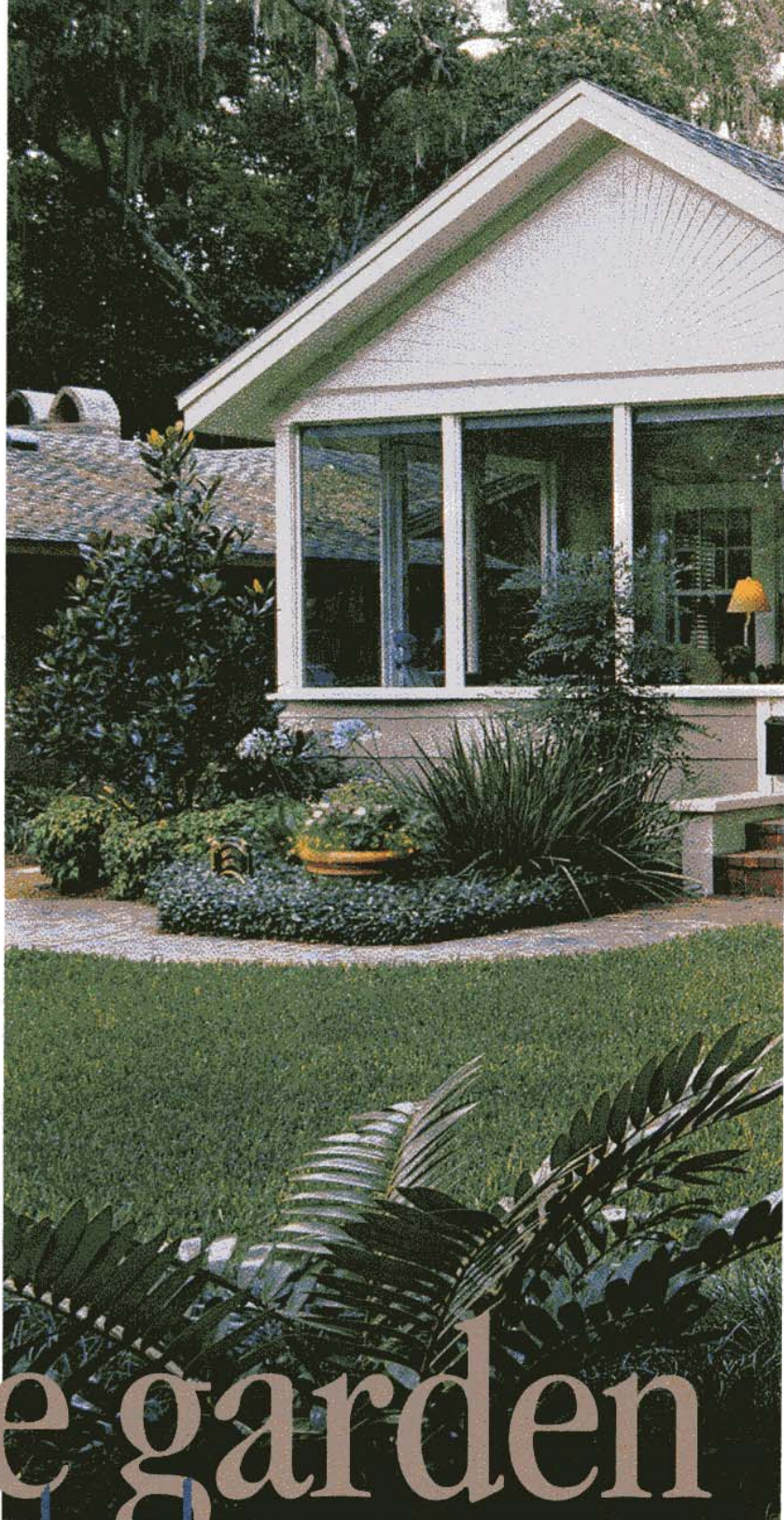
In our supersize-it culture, Kim and Jan Moore are turning the world on its head. They believe smaller can be better, and when you visit their home and
